- English I

## **Health Education: .5 credit**

- Required Sophomore year

## **Math: 3 credits (4 credits recommended)**

- Taken in succession, dependent on what level you begin with Freshman year

## **Physical Education \*\*: 2.5 credits**

- Physical Education I is required Freshman year
- Physical Education Electives (1.5 cr.) maybe be taken Sophomore, Junior or Senior years

## **Public Speaking \*: .5 credit**

- This course may be taken any year, either semester

## **Religious Studies: 4 credits**

- Freshman Religion
- Christian Scriptures
- Hebrew Scriptures
- Morality
- Peace and Justice \*\*\*
